




James Law, PhD



JAMES LAW is Professor of Speech and Language Science at Newcastle University. He has had research grant funding of in the order of £9m and has published over 250 peer reviewed and other publications. Recently a lead of the UK's Better Communication Research Programme, the Australian Centre for Research Excellence in Child Language and was chair of Cost Action IS1406 Enhancing children's oral language skills across Europe and beyond: A collaboration focusing on interventions for children learning their first language until early 2019. He is now running a programme grant Social InEquality and its Effects on child Development (SEED): A study of birth cohorts in the UK, Germany and the Netherlands and another developing an early language identification measure for health visitors in England. He became an officer of the Order of the British Empire in 2018 and was awarded a Lifetime Achievement Award from the International Association of Logopedics and Phoniatrics (IALP) in 2019.
